

## Media Player Instructions

The Codec and player for the DFS movies is a free download from the Internet, and this is how John and I set them up:

Navigate to [www.free-codecs.com/K\\_Lite\\_Codec\\_Pack\\_download.htm](http://www.free-codecs.com/K_Lite_Codec_Pack_download.htm)

Download [K-Lite Codec Pack 2.61 Full] About 14 MB

You should end up with an executable install file called `klcodec261f.exe`

Invoke this installer and follow these instructions:

Skip through the information and destination pages by hitting Next

On the Profile page, choose Profile 2, Playback only

Make sure Player: Media Player Classic is checked  
Hit Next

On the Start up page, leave the defaults and hit Next

On the next page, Uncheck the following:

Make Media Player Classic the default player for:  
Decode the following audio formats with ffdshow  
Hit Next

Install

Finish

Find Media Player Classic in:

`c:\Program Files\K-Lite Codec Pack\Media Player Classic`  
Send `mplayerc.exe` to the Desktop

Invoke Media Player Classic and run a DFS movie.
